**Connection Requirements**

- Microsoft requires global administrator credentials with MFA enabled for the M365 tenant associated with Partner Center to be used when activating this integration
- MFA must be challenged during login – If a conditional access policy allows you to login without the MFA challenge, Partner Center may not grant credentials needed to activate the integration
- The account must also have the Partner Center "Admin Agent" role assigned

**Microsoft GDAP deadline** – Microsoft is sunsetting Delegated Admin Privileges (DAP) in Partner Center. They will begin transitioning DAP relationships to Granular Delegated Admin Privileges (GDAP) on May 22nd, 2023. 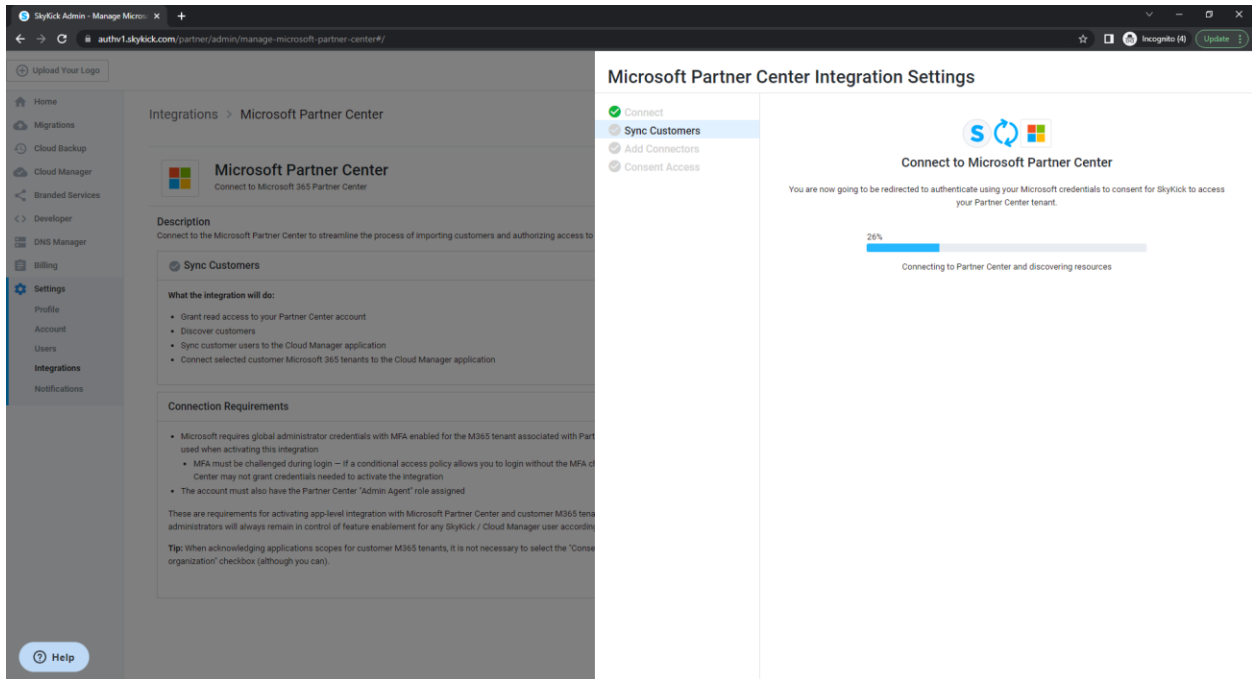

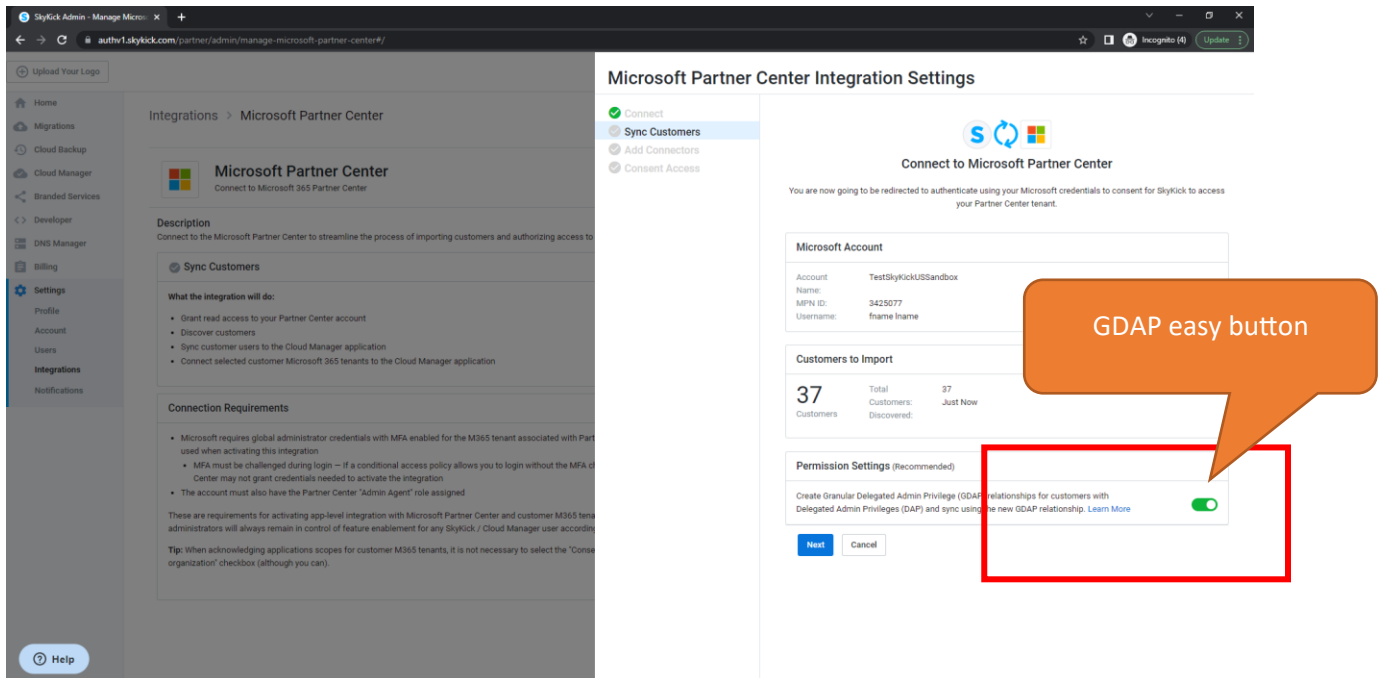
